These plans set out priorities for the funding for the next four years.

Thank you to everyone who has got involved and had their say. I believe that we have developed exciting plans that reflect what we have heard from local people and which will bring real long-lasting improvements for Spalding.

Our plans for Spalding

The ten-year vision and four-year investment plan provide a framework for the delivery of the £20M [Pride in Place funding](#) which begins from April 2026 and set out the themes that the funding will be spent on. These are safety and security, town centre revitalisation, town centre business diversification, cultural and heritage provision, and events and markets.

These have been chosen as the priorities for the funding as from the consultation we know that these things really matter to local people.

Whilst the vision and plan set out the themes and the ambition for Spalding, the detail of the projects and activities under the themes will be developed in the coming months. In this way, we can make sure that the funding is invested where it can make a difference.



The Board has already invested early funding into a hotspot policing pilot as we know that safety and security is key for local people.

After South Holland District Council Cabinet approved the vision and plan on Monday, 24th November, the vision and investment plan were submitted to government by the deadline of 28th November.

We expect a response from the government in early 2026 with the first lot of funding to be released in April 2026.
